Major Capabilities of Release 1

R1C.2 – Late 2008

- Replacement of *GPO Access* functionality and migration of content
- Manage content & metadata in packages
- Exchange descriptive metadata between FDsys and ILS
- Ensure authenticity and digitally sign PDF documents

Major Capabilities of Release 1

R1C.3 – Mid 2009

- Congressional submission of content and jobs
- Assign persistent names (Handles) to content
- Enhance search and access functionality

Major Capabilities of Release 1

R1C.4 – Late 2009

- Agency submission of content and jobs
- Provide a documented interface (API) to allow searching by non-GPO systems
- Enable navigation of relationships between publications
- Send email and RSS notifications

Major Capabilities of Release 2

- Automatically gather information from Federal agency websites (harvest)
- Acquire, integrate, or link content from external sources
- Bulk PDF signing
- Online GPO Bookstore interface
- Customizable alert services

Major Capabilities of Release 3

- Section 508 Compliant User Interfaces
- Access to content published in non-English and non-Roman character sets
- Delivery by FTP
- Support granularity for audio and video
