

- **Free, 24/7 access, anywhere, anytime** – no special logins or fees
- Access to almost 1 million publication records with valuable information about U.S. Government information resources including:
 - Title
 - Author
 - Publisher
 - Distributor
 - Content type
 - Related keywords
 - Available formats
 - Description
- Links to full-text documents, reports, articles, eBooks, forms, posters, and more
- Access primary source material.

- Easy searching by keyword, title, agency, and subject
