



Federal Advisory Committee Act

"To authorize the establishment of a system governing the creation and operation of advisory committees in the executive branch of the Federal Government, and for other purposes."







Advisory committees should:

- Be established only when they are determined to be essential.
- Be terminated when they are no longer carrying out the purposes for which they were established.
- Be governed by standards and uniform procedures.
- Function as advisory only.





The Congress and the public should be kept informed with respect to the number, purpose, membership, activities, and cost of advisory committees.





GPO and **FACA**

§ 108. Advisory committees

The Public Printer may establish advisory committees to obtain advice and recommendations for the Government Printing Office in the same manner, and subject to the same terms and conditions, applicable to an agency under the Federal Advisory Committee Act.







Depository Library Council

The Depository Library Council serves in an advisory capacity to the Director of the Government Publishing Office on matters that relate to improving public access to our Government's information through the Public Information Programs of the Superintendent of Documents:

- Federal Depository Library Program
- Cataloging and Indexing Program
- GPO's System of Online Access, govinfo

The DLC shall provide advice on policy and operational matters that provide and support services to Federal depository libraries.


