AACR2: Anglo-American Cataloguing Rules, 2<sup>nd</sup> edition – the previous cataloging standard  
AAP: Authorized Access Point (formerly called “heading”)  
Bib record: bibliographic record  
CGP: Catalog of Government Publications (maintained by GPO)  
ILS: Integrated Library System  
LC: Library of Congress  
LC NACO File: also known as the LC Name Authority File  
MARC: Machine Readable Cataloging (also MARC 21)  
NACO: Name Authority Cooperative – the component of the PCC for name authority records  
NAR: Name Authority Record  
OCLC: Online Computer Library Center – a shared bibliographic catalog, also known as WorldCat  
PCC: Program for Cooperative Cataloging  
RDA: Resource Description and Access – the new cataloging standard
