As campus moved to Stage 2A of its Reopening Campus plan based on the Maryland Strong Roadmap to Recovery state plan, the Library Managers and Interim Library Co-Directors received approval to plan for partial reopening of the Library 1st floor for supporting the few high level labs and hands-on classes meeting on campus, student reservations for computer usage and study table space, and curbside pickup of requested equipment and books. No patron activity on the 2nd and 3rd floors, and extremely limited use of displays, flyers, and handout materials to keep surfaces clean.
