Join the <u>Cataloging Record Distribution</u>

<u>Program (CRDP)</u>, a service available only to

Federal depository libraries.

GPO contracts with MARCIVE, Inc. for this bibliographic record service.



The CRDP will provide your library with:

- Monthly sets of <u>GPO produced catalog records</u> at no cost.
- Options to develop your <u>library's CRDP</u> customized profile.

CRDP Profile Options include:

- All newly created cataloging records or
- All newly created records, plus <u>changed or</u> updated bibliographic records

And (optionally)

- Catalog records without item numbers or records which include inactive item numbers, identified through selection of desired SuDocs stems
- FDLP Basic Collection catalog records
- · Monthly Records Lists (aka titles lists)
- Holding records for OCLC

Record sets are organized per custom options.
