GPO's Registry of Digitization Projects

- http://registry.fdlp.gov/
- Around 170 collections
 - FRUS, Labor Dept. Children's Bureau
 Publications, Public Papers of the Presidents, etc.
- Many federal projects not listed
- Projects reflect institutional bias
- Not comprehensive
- Increase participation



TRAIL

- Federal tech reports prior to 1975
- Over 20,000 reports scanned to date
- Enhanced cataloging & shared management of print collections
- Deposited to HathiTrust thru UMich participation
- On GPO Registry
- Moved to <u>CRL</u> in 2010.
- Membership model.





OSTI

- On demand digitization
- No organizes retrospective digitization effort
- GPO Registry
- Adopt-a-Doc \$85
- Information Bridge 239,596 (58,000 pre-1991)
- Some libraries loading MARC records
- TRAIL




CIC/Google Project

- Cross agency cooperation!!






