

Digitization Status of the U.S. Serial Set

- LAW & GPO have started a large, 10-year effort to digitize and make accessible volumes of the US Congressional Serial Set back to the first volume, published in 1817.
- Pilot Project: 1,069 volumes digitized during Fiscal 2019.
- Plan is to digitize an estimated 15,850 volumes spanning 177 years and including 73,000 maps and foldouts.

Serial Set Partnership – GPO and the Law Library

Law Library:

- Manages the digitization of Serial Set volumes
- Provides accepted digitized volumes to the GPO

Government Publishing Office (GPO):

- Will provide cataloging of the Serial Set volumes and documents
- Adding authentication to the PDF files
- Providing Serial Set volumes that are missing or incomplete in the Library's collections
- The digitized Serial Set will be available through both the Library of Congress and GPO websites (govinfo).



Digitization Status of the U.S. Serial Set

Performance Target: Expand the digitization of law collections to better meet the demand for online access to collections by continuing the digitization initiative, and digitizing 3,500 volumes of the U.S. Serial Set by September 30, 2020.

Q1: Prepare 875 volumes and send to digitization	1,094 volumes had been prepared for shipment to the vendor.
Q2: Prepare 875 volumes and send to digitization (1750 total)	A total of 2,351 volumes had been prepared for shipment to the vendor
Q3: Prepare 875 volumes and send to digitization (2625 total)	A total of 2,351 volumes had been prepared for shipment to the vendor.
Q4: Prepare 875 volumes and send to digitization (3,500 total)	A total of 2,602 volumes had been prepared for shipment to the vendor.



Digitization Status of the U.S. Serial Set

FY21 Goals:

- Prepare and digitize 3,000 volumes
- Publishing a subset of the Serial Set (69th Congress) as a P1 digital collection.



US Serial Set Physical Characteristics

- Digitizing 15th through the 103rd Congresses
- Over 15,700 volumes containing around 12 million pages
- Range of page count of a couple dozen pages to around 2000 pages
 - Foldouts
 - Maps
 - Oversized maps



Tableau: Contractor Statistical Report





Metadata Guide: Identifying

Instructions for documenting and formatting metadata are included in the guides.

These tables are updated regularly as new information that should be recorded is discovered in the Serial Set.

The goal of metadata tracking is to create unique terms for Serial Set content so that it can easily be retrieved through a query search.

Observation Table


Double-clicking in the observation free text box will retrieve a list of options and their proper format to guide the documentation of inspection notes. If any content worth noting appears in the volume but not explicitly from the observation choices, note the content verbatim as it appears in the volume.

Metadata Guide: Formatting

Formatting metadata observations is especially important to communicate any print or digitization errors among staff and to our vendors.





Metadata Guide: Documenting

Metadata is both qualitative

Special Content: Foldouts, Maps, and Plates Content: Description: Foldouts* Can be charts, plans, and tables that have larger dimensions than standard volume pages. Two-Page Maps or plates that fold out from the center of the Spread* volume. Generally found in Signal Officer or Weather Bureau reports. Maps Include any geographical content. Usually identifiable by keys, legends, titles, etc. Color maps have their own count. Oversize Have dimensions larger than 74" x 37". They should count three times - 1 foldout, 1 map OR 1 color map, 1 oversized. Color Plans, charts, tables, illustrations, etc. with any plates | amount of color ink. Formatting: Description: [special Indicates a total # of foldouts, maps, or content] (#) plates [#] p. # [special | Indicates foldout, map, or plate within a content] document #/page # [special | Indicates foldout, map, or plate by content] no. # chronological order – usually in volumes consisting solely of foldouts or singular

and quantitative.

COUNTING:

- * = Quantitative data. Any and all foldout maps (standard and oversized), color maps, and color plates should be counted twice once as the type of foldout/spread (map, color, or color plate) and once as a foldout OR spread. However, maps, color maps, and color plates are not exclusively foldouts total the count of standard page maps, color maps, and color plates in addition to that of foldout maps, color maps, and color plates in these fields.
- ** = Oversize maps count as one oversize, one map, or color map depending on the content. Indicate oversize content when using the database evaluation form.



Adapting to New Challenges


The Serial Set project continues to prioritize evaluation of physical and digital volumes in online and socially distant environments.

- Combining onsite and GPO volumes, marking as "RETURN"
- Prioritizing Sampler QR (PILOT, and then Full)
- Shifting focus to publicity efforts (Story Maps and Blogs)
- Coordinating with contractors to pack Ready to Ship volumes and evaluate volumes pulled for blog research





The Serial Set also contains a copy of the map of the proposed state of Sequoyah:




