NAL - History

- 150 years old in 2012
- Originated as part of the Secretary's Office in 1862 with 1,000 books
- 1920 150,000 books
- 1956 1.05 million books
- 1982 1.7 million books
- Named a National Library in 1962
- Re-located to Beltsville in 1969





The Library Today

- World's largest agricultural library since 1898
- An unparalleled body of knowledge
 - ~ 2.5+ million books
 - ~ 3.5+ million USDA reports
 - ~ 13,000 periodicals
 - ~ 5,500 electronic journals & newspapers
- Ranks 11th for uniqueness among 123 research libraries
 - 166,435 unique book and journal titles
 - ~ 9 times the ARL average of 19,000








