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Not Your Traditional Library!

National-level program

- Our tangible collection is the materials we distribute to around 1,200 depository libraries; no tangible collection at GPO
- Electronic collection of documents linked to via PURLs and accessible from the Catalog of U.S. Government Publications (CGP)
 - Links to documents via GPO's Federal Digital System, FDsys
 - Links to documents and information resources on Federal Agency websites
 - Harvested content performed by LSCM staff and through contract with Internet Archive using Heritrix
- Technical services work for all libraries, acquisitions, classification, cataloging
- Tools and services for Federal Depository Libraries and the public



Cataloging and Indexing Program

TITLE 44--PUBLIC PRINTING AND DOCUMENTS CHAPTER 17--DISTRIBUTION AND SALE OF PUBLIC DOCUMENTS

Sec. 1710. Index of documents: number and distribution

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The Superintendent of Documents... shall prepare and publish a comprehensive index of public documents The head of each executive department, independent agency and establishment of the Government shall deliver to him a copy of every document issued or published by the department, bureau, or office not confidential in character.

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Federal Depository Library Program

Congress provides GPO funding to disseminate government documents to Depository Libraries and to catalog and index government documents as laid out in Title 44, Chapter 19:

§ 1901. Definition of Government publication

"Government publication" as used in this chapter, means informational matter which is published as an individual document at Government expense, or as required by law.

Classify

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- Superintendent of Documents classification numbers
- Library of Congress classification of Congressional documents
- Acquire, harvest, and identify new information in scope of the C & I and FDLP Programs
- Utilize ILS (Aleph 500)
 - OPAC: the Catalog of U.S. Government Publications (CGP)
 - Other CGP services: GPO's MetaLib, Federal Depository Library Directory (FDLD), Locate in a Library feature

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Technical Services What We do

Catalog

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- PURL and assist with harvesting and archiving of electronic resources
- Develop plans, processes, projects, and studies that support the operational units within LSCM
- · Distribute tangible publications to libraries in the FDLP
- Create shipping lists
- Manage microfiche contracts and processing of materials for microfiche (MF) conversion
- Answer AskGPO questions



Technical Services Staff

- Professional librarians: Cataloging, serials work, ILS operations, project management, workflow analysis, technical writing, etc.
- Support positions: technical services work, pre-cataloging, serials check-in, acquisitions, technical processing, etc.
- Contract support for various projects

Projections for the future:

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- Retirement eligible workforce, succession planning initiatives
- Changing workflow from predominately tangible to electronic
- · Major shift in services and deliverables

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Overview of the Acquisitions Process

- Acquire documents from all 3 branches of the U.S. Government
- Determine whether documents are in scope of the FDLP and the Cataloging and Indexing Program
- Determine distribution approach: tangible or electronic
- Perform preliminary classification
- · Prepare brief bibliographic record
- Send document on to be classified and catalogued



Methods to Acquire

- Ride print order: order tangible stock (1 copy or bulk stock)
- Review agency Web sites (identify pubs for harvesting)
- Look at tangible publications, including U.S. Government periodicals
- Check bibliographies, publication announcements, references to other titles
- Receive material through 'deposit' agreements

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- Suggestions from FDLP and library community, i.e., Lost Docs
- Develop agency contacts: in person meetings and Discovery document interface (agencies report new content via email)
- Identify publications acquired for GPO Sales Program
- Monitor agency listservs and announcement services, blogs, radio, and news articles

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Technical Processing Unit

- Microfiche conversion and contracts
- Shipping List preparation
- SuDoc classification for tangible publications
- Order processing and serial check-in for tangible titles that are being shipped to FDL's.
- Coordinate with physical distribution of materials at the Laurel Warehouse.



Cataloging Work

De facto national cataloging authority for U.S. Government Documents

- Title 44 of U.S. Code: requirement for the Cataloging and Indexing Program
- Historic Monthly Catalog and the online catalog, 'CGP' Participate in national forums and initiatives related to our mission
 - Program for Cooperative Cataloging (PCC), CONSER, NACO, SACO, Bibco
 - ILS User group ExLibris

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- Digitization standards, metadata policy, etc.
- OCLC daily contributions

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Bibliographic Control

- Cataloging Basics
 - Catalog a variety of formats
 - Create bibliographic metadata
- Create content metadata for FDSys content collections (Statues at Large and Bound Congressional Record)
- PURLs, harvesting, and archiving assistance
- CGP quality and authority control activities



Standards Utilized

- RDA Full implementation, April 2013, NACO/SACO authorized. As of July 1, 6,637 records created/updated
- MARC 21 Specifications for Record Structure, Character Sets, and Exchange Media: structural format used since its inception prior to format integration that characterizes MARC 21
- OCLC: Charter member since July 1976; GPO holds enhancement privileges for all formats
- Library of Congress (LC) Program for Cooperative Cataloging (PCC): participant in all branches, viz., BIBCO, CONSER, NACO, & SACO
- Library of Congress Subject Headings (LCSH) and NASA Thesaurus

Challenges in Technical Services

- Title 44 mandate for submission to GPO, but no enforcement mechanism
- · Quantity of materials
- Scope determinations
- Version control

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- Format decisions
- Characteristics of online publications
 - Tendency to disappear, priority processing, harvesting complexities, etc.

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LTS Metrics

- Cataloging approx. 2,000 new titles cataloged each month, May 2013 – 1,281
- 28,000 active serial titles in various formats; over 196,286 serial issues checked in since October 2012
- PURLs created: May 2013 696
- New acquisitions: approx. 2,000 each month; May 2013 1,281
- Tool Usage:
 - May 2013: Catalog of Government Publications (CGP): 1, 200, 572 searches
 - FY12: GPO's MetaLib: 149,542
 - FY12: FDL Directory (FDLD): 59,283 by public users
 - FY12: Locate in a Library feature: 14,039



FY 2010-2013 Projects

National Bibliographic Inventory Project

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- Historic Shelflist transcription project: major portion completed in December, 2011; Between November 1, 2012 and June 7, 2013, 3,437 shelflist records were transcribed; MOCAT vol. transcription, 1895, 1898.
- Historic Shelflist digitization project completed in Spring, 2012
- Serials management: ongoing, new and historic issues being checked in to the CGP, patterns created. Over 2,500 patterns created since work began in 2007.
- Cooperative cataloging partnerships: Univ. of Montana, Univ. of Florida. To date: over 830 titles cataloged

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FY 2010-2013 Projects

- Cataloging Records Distribution Project (CRDP): Fiscal Year 2010 to current; cataloging records distributed to 75 Federal Depository Libraries based on their selection profile
- Resource Description and Access (RDA)
- Harvesting Initiative using Heritrix: 7,286,846 new files and 1144 GB of new data harvested: Small agencies currently the target
- Microfiche (MF) review
- Database clean-up efforts
