

Background

- GPO's Federal Digital System (FDsys) was publicly launched on January 15, 2009.
- The FDsys public website provides users with access to hundreds of thousands of legislative, executive, and judicial documents.
- There have been almost two billion document retrievals since FDsys launched.

- 1. A complete redesign of the public website
- 2. New features and enhancements requested by users
- 3. New hardware
- 4. New open-source search engine

Public Beta Launch – January

Beta Phase

- Subset of collections and functionality available
- Incorporation of user feedback
- In parallel with current FDsys
