About Harford Community College Library







- HCC Library is about a 17% selective. Item selection is based on the needs of our patrons to support academic curriculum and the community.
- Formats for the items we select include print, CD, and electronic.
- HCC Library is 1 of 60 selective federal depositories in a region of Maryland, Delaware, and the District of Columbia all covered by the Regional depository library at McKeldin Library at the University of Maryland College Park.
- HCC Library is 1 of only 3 community college library depositories in this region of MD, DE, and DC, and only 1 of 2 community college library depositories in MD.
- All of our print Government Documents are fully integrated into all of our collections, following the Library of Congress classification.
- We maintain the GPO item number and Superintendents of Documents Classification number in all their bibliographic records that we get through the CRDP.









Historical Facts of HCC Library to Depository Library Status


- Only 10 years after Harford Junior College's founding in 1957, Clarence D. Long of the 2nd District in Maryland felt it was important for a depository library at HJC. On January 17, 1967, Congressman Long sent a letter to HJC President Joseph N. Hankin stating that he had nominated HJC Library for depository status in the FDLP.
- Population had grown due to U.S. Government installations at Aberdeen Proving Ground, Bainbridge Naval Training Center, and Edgewood Arsenal, and to growing industries and agriculture in Harford County, with an expanding Division of Continuing Education at HJC.
- After Congressman Long's designation letter with statements and Superintendent of Documents Carper Buckley's June 1st letters noting he had signed HJC Library into depository status, a June 9th letter from Virginia Phillips at the Regional to HJC Library states that HJC had "been added to the official list of designated depositories for government publications in Maryland."
- Due to redistricting, today Harford Community College is located in the 1st Congressional District.











Proposal for a 50th FDLP Celebration

- Gathered and written by Andie Craley, Depository Coordinator and Jen Hart, Library Assistant in Government Documents and submitted to Library Director Carol Allen in May 2016.
- Held until November 2016 when listed as agenda item for the Library Management Team (LMT).
- Proposal discussed to either focus on National Library Week 2017 or Constitution Day 2017 as the date of celebration when there is more potential for campus interaction.
- Actual 50th FDLP Anniversary is June 1, 2017, when only a smaller summer semester on campus.
- LMT decided to focus on Monday September 18, 2017 for the FDLP 50th celebration with Constitution Day and do a promotional event during the April 2017 National Library Week to advertise the upcoming anniversary.
- Elements included possible tie in with HCC campus' 60th celebration and with APG Centennial in 2017, activities like a Gov Doc Scavenger Hunt in the stacks, the proposed speaker for Constitution Day, and proposed invitation list.













Planning

- Library Director asked to hold planning until the campus administration had decided on events for the campus' 60th celebration events in order to tie in the celebrations.
- In January 2017, requested FDLP Glass Award and requested attendance by the GPO with a tentative date of September 18, 2017. GPO attendance was confirmed to attend.
- In February 2017, requested local historian David Fisher to present his "Scientist & Inventor" Benjamin Franklin program for the Constitution Day program and he accepted.
- Notified my Regional Librarian Celina McDonald at University of Maryland College Park and asked her to "hold the date" to attend.
- Notified retired Gov Doc Librarian Pam Schott and asked her to "hold the date" to attend. Pam had been at HJC when it came into depository status, and taught Jen and I everything we know!
- In March 2017, the campus administration approved the invitation list to request special dignitaries and community partners to attend the awards program, and the list to request official proclamations and/or citations.

















- In April 2017, decisions finalized to hold the FDLP 50th awards ceremony on Monday September 18 in conjunction with celebrating Constitution Day.
- Local historian David Fisher's "Scientist and Inventor" Benjamin Franklin Constitution Day program would tie into Hays-Heighe House's "APG Tech Revolution" and "HCC's 60th Anniversary" exhibits and the Library's FDLP 50th anniversary awards event.

- Events listed in weekly employee online newsletter "News & Whooos" starting in September 2017.
- Events and article in the online Spring and Fall 2017 HCC Library Quarterly Newsletters













