



H.R. 5305: Highlights

- Deposit of digital content in depository libraries
- Preservation services
- Gift authority
- Regulatory process
- Processes for Federal agencies for the delivery of content to the Superintendent of Documents



H.R. 5305: Minimum Requirements for FDLs

- Provide members of the public with no-fee access to all of the IDPs furnished to the library by GPO.
- Ensure that a member of the library staff is knowledgeable about the use of the online repository.
- Meet other Superintendent requirements established by promulgated regulations.



H.R. 5305: Number of Depository Libraries

- Provide regulations that limit the number of libraries designated as selective depository libraries.
- Limit the number of regional depository libraries located in any state to 2.
- Provide for the designation of at least 2 regional depository libraries in each census region.
- Any depository library may request to be designated a preservation depository library.

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H.R. 5305: Regional Depository Libraries

- Provide access to selected IDPs in tangible form as provided by the Superintendent.
- May decline to receive IDPs in tangible form
- Provides access to all IDPs regardless of form or format.
- Coordinate and collaborate with selective depository libraries to maintain access to its collection of tangible IDPs.
- Agree to provide services to selective depository libraries.



H.R. 5305: Selective Depository Libraries

- Provide access to selected IDPs in tangible form as provided by the Superintendent.
- Maintain its collection of tangible IDPs for a minimum of 5 years after receipt, unless authorized to by the Superintendent withdraw materials earlier.
- Collaborates with a Regional Depository Library on the maintenance of a regional collection of tangible IDPs.
- No limit on the number of selective depositories.

Current Program Elements not in H.R. 5305

- Firsthand investigations of libraries for which need is indicated
- Libraries reporting on condition of libraries every two years
- By-law designation of depositories
- Classified list for items available for selection
- Regionals providing reference service, ILL, and assistance to selectives with disposition of materials
- Minimum requirement of 10,000 books in the library



If H.R. 5305 does not pass...

The Superintendent of Documents is committed to moving the FDLP forward on current projects and initiatives for a more digital program within the boundaries of Title 44 and appropriated funding

- Digitization and move collections in **govinfo**
- Acquisitions/cataloging
- Preservation
- Outreach and services to libraries



If H.R. 5305 passes: New Responsibilities

- Deposit of digital content in depository libraries
- Preservation services
- Gift authority
- Regulatory process
- Processes for Federal agencies for the delivery of content to the Superintendent of Documents

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If H.R. 5305 passes: ...

- Library designations currently in place will remain in place
- Need to make some decisions about what we are currently doing that is not in H.R 5305
- New provisions will not happen over night
- Priorities to be established based on whether the following will be needed:
 - Additional staff
 - Increase in appropriations
 - Research and development
 - Contracts to be awarded
 - New processes established



Current Priorities and Initiatives

- Hiring more staff
 - Technical Services Librarians
 - Curriculum Development/Instruction Librarians
 - Preservation support
- Building relationships with agencies
- Preservation services
- Preservation steward inventories
- Ramping up
 - Identification and acquisition of content
 - Web harvesting
 - Cataloging



Working On

- Preservation services pilots
- Investigating digital deposit
- Systems modernization
 - Implementation of Primo
 - SalesForce CRM implementation
 - Future phases of FDLP eXchange
- FDLP assessments



FY 2019 Appropriations

- GPO requested: \$117M
- SOD requested \$32M
- Increase to be spent on:
- U.S. Code distribution
- Additional positions
- Locating and acquiring content
- Agency outreach
- Digitization historic documents
- Preservation of tangible collections in FDLs
- House approved Legislative Branch Appropriations (06/08) and the Senate Appropriations Committee (06/15) approved GPO's full request of \$117M, including the increase for the FDLP
