WHY NOAA?



- Integral to URI's mission as a Land and Sea Grant University
- URI and the state played an active role in NOAA's creation
- Library Dean was supportive about this collection becoming part of the program

From a preservation point of view

- NOAA hasn't undergone a major reorganization since its creation in 1970 and the SuDoc numbering is consistent
- Agency was created a few years before GPO cataloging started in 1976 so most titles have authoritative records

Continuing Cataloging and Preservation Methods

- Run periodic updates in our ExLibris (ALMA) ILS to maintain accurate information and ensure that the preservation notes are included in all new materials going forward.
- Designate all NOAA materials in the catalog to non-circulating (Library Use Only)
- Apply metadata and preservation standards to new and donated material
- Periodically update spreadsheet on all NOAA materials and the condition that the material is in (Good/Poor).

Heavy rainfall, even for short periods, may be quickly followed by Flash Floods in mountain areas. When you go into hilly terrain, think Flash Floods when it rains. A little caution can save your life, and your family's.

-STAY AWAY FROM NATURAL STREAMBEDS, arroyos, and other drainage channels during and after rainstorms. Water runs off the higher elevations very rapidly, causing the natural drainage system to overflow with rushing floodwaters and their deadly cargo of rocks, mud, smashed trees, and other debris.

--NEVER CAMP ON LOW GROUND. A flash flood can catch you while you sleep.

-USE YOUR MAPS. Know where you are, and whether you are on locally low ground. Remember: You don't have to be at the bottom of a hill to be a target for the dangers of flash flooding.

-KNOW WHERE THE HIGH GROUND IS and how to get there in a hurry. Remember: many roads and trails parallel existing drainage patterns, and may be swept away by flood waters.

-STAY OUT OF FLOODED AREAS; the water may still be rising, and the current is usually swift. Never try to cross a flowing stream on foot if the water is above your knees.

-ABANDON STALLED VEHICLES IN FLOODED AREAS if you can do so safely. Flood waters may rise and sweep the vehicle (and its occupants) away. Many deaths have resulted from attempts to move stalled vehicles.

--KEP ALERT TO SIGNS OF WET WEATHER, either rain where you are or signs of rain--thunder and lightning--nearby or in distant hills. --KEP AS INFORMED AS YOU CAN. Stay tuned to radio or television stations in the area for information on developing weather and flood stations in the area for information on developing weather and flood to watch for these indicates of fige of broadcast information, be sure flow; steady or rapid rise in river level. FLASH-FLOOD WATCH: Heavy rains may result in flash flooding in the specified area. Be alert and prepare for the possibility of a flood emergency which will require immediate action.

The Unexpected and Some Challenges

- The cost to implement the program was modest but it was more than zero
- The extent of what we didn't own but should was greater than expected
- What to do about older serials that predated NOAA but eventually ended up under NOAA (decided to add the full run into the program)
- Found material in LC stacks that may or may not have been published by NOAA (had to do some detective work)
- Found titles purchased in print but received depository copies as microfiche
- "Saving the family photos from the burning house" syndrome was strong
