The simple answer is that the fair labor standards act does not -- it is not a federal thing. It does not require that we are basically given other holidays. There are exceptions to that for government contracts that do specify specific vacation time. But in general most of us have to rely on our state laws or on the goodness of our private employers to give us vacation or holiday time off. I just included a couple examples to give you an idea. If you do go to that website, you can find information about that. Just to make your day when we are about to have Christmas vacation. You really aren't entitled to Christmas vacation necessarily. The government official -is called recreation.gov. We will take a look at the end of the presentation. Recreation.gov compiles information for 3500 government facilities and 100 thousand individual sites across the country. They provide record hates all opportunities through the United States government. Camping, tours, horseback riding, that is on recreation.gov. I will add a personal note here that during this past summer my husband and I bought an entry every day pass and we spent 30 days writing and Amtrak circling around the country. I'm one of the biggest things was the F Park service as a program with Amtrak that if you are on the train and an area that is close to a forest or a park or a national not monument someone from the park Severus service gets on the train and explained that to you. It was a really nice part of the experience that I had no idea existed. That is one of the things the government provides for recreational activity. Other sites that provide information about recreation is the U.S. Forest Service. They have information for adults and kids how to visit the US for service and what you can do there. So more sites the National Park Service. We are going to go live at the end of the presentation so you can see what is in that site. The United States system of national parks is unique in the world. It covers all 50 states and all of the United States territories. It started when Yellowstone was named as the first national park. And some still great government size the national register for historical places which is part of the National Park Service provides information about endless list of all those buildings and places and sometimes that includes whole towns or parts of city that are said as historical places under the national preservation act of 1966. And still more great government sites. I would tell you your life is not complete if you had not visited at least some of the museums of the Smithsonian Institute. There are total of 19 world-class museums. Most of them and Washington DC. Most of them are free. If you haven't been, they are well worth the visit. We can also take a look at the Smithsonian site at the end. In the course of going through this am looking through vacation sites and places. These are just three that I thought were interesting. There are multiple state and local sites included in USA.gov for vacations and recreation. I included these the city of Asheville North Carolina has some very interesting things. The California state parks has numerous and lovely state parks within the state of California. And then New Hampshire's site is a list of her horse historical sites in New Hampshire. A small sampling for what is there are local and state sites to visit. And I could not leave the catalog of [low volume] I search for vacation and came up with a number of publications. These three particular look interesting. The first one vacation nation is about how tourism benefits United economy and that was very interesting. And the second one know before you go is a very useful publication about things that you should know before you leave the United States to travel internationally. The third one I thought was interesting because it was actually a joint publication with the University of Iowa and the United States government called the winter vacation now. I thought those three were interesting examples of individual publications that you can find within the catalog of US Government publications. Videos. The first one is national wildlife refuge week which talks about all of those

wildlife refuges and the second one is only for the very brave and not particularly on my vacation list but firm no -- discernible Mac handling and release of a shark. And the final one is general video from the US departments of interior unrest deviations -- if you just want to keep watching more and more videos the National Park Service has its own YouTube channel. They have numerous videos and involving the various national parks. You could actually if you can't go to the parks or want to take a nice virtual vacation this is a fun place to go. You can also follow them on Facebook and on Twitter to see what is going on in the United States national Park. Okay. If you are tired of the United States, and you want to see more of, what you have to do? First thing you need is a passport. Here is the site with the Department of State for applying for a passport. And then you are probably going to want to know about before I leave. The USA.gov the site itself has a page dedicated to international travel issues for Americans. Finally, if you are interested in maintaining your house and what is going on healthwise and how you can obtain healthcare and other places that you visit the CDC Travelers health Prince provides that information through this site of the CEC.

[indiscernible]. And always, though the of you that know me I have to come up with what exists in the Spanish. There was not a lot this year. These were interesting. The first one was [indiscernible] even here in Puerto Rico way or we have a whole lot of holidays that are Puerto Rican holidays a lot of people are confused about what our official US federal holidays. So if you have users from other country they may also be confused about what those are and smack. The second site is lame for people who want to travel outside of the United States. I wasn't quite sure how to put these as they were serendipity that came along was looking at information for vacations and they are both interesting. The first one is information in Spanish about how you can register to vote absentee and few are not going to be where you live when it comes time to vote. On the second one, if you will place that you run as a vacation site -- I don't know if this is applied to the air B&B. Jane, can you hear me? You just went on mute.

Many people from other countries simply do not know because what our national holidays and their country are not United States holidays. In particular, Thanksgiving. This is the lesson Spanish list in Spanish as the official US government holidays. The second one is resources and Spanish for people for the United States if you want to travel outside of the United States. These are two things I came across, the first one is information is and Spanish and how to vote absentee valid if you are not going to be in your area for vacation or other reasons when it's time to vote. And for mesh and information for them the IRS if you rent an apartment or any part of your house for vacation purposes there are certain expenses that you may be able to deduct on your income tax forms and this is the IRS topic that is related to that particular subject area. There is not as much information as on vacation and travel. These are three examples of interesting sites that I came across. This was very interesting about travel and recreation and hobbies felt like it was a unusual thing to come across. The second one is for the Institute of aging has to do with when you retire as you age finding activities that you enjoy. It can include all kinds of activities and

hobbies. And the final one is from the career outlook how you might turn your hobby into a career. Those were three of the examples that a came across looking for hobbies and leisure time activities.

I am going to go to sharing my desktop and go to these three sites and several others live so you could take Outlook with those look like. Here we go. The first one quickly this is the travel and tourism account which gives information on what tourists spend and the price they pay online seeing and airfare for this site is intended to provide us that of employment and sales industries for any of you who may live in an area tourism can be a big business. Important to be able to access for those of you that are it is interesting just this little bit here. There was the 7.1 increase on tourism spending. That is pretty good. Go take a look of this. [low volume] you can see or search list starting in 1976. Let's just go to the latest one. On this list are a school in Idaho another school in Idaho and entire historical district in the area of Greenville. A church and school in Indiana. Just to give you an idea of what gets listed on the national register historic places and they are probably places to close that you live that would be interesting to visit. [low volume] heart, Jane. You just want on mute again. Jane, can you hear me? My back now? I went to the Smithsonian site and what I did is I called up just to take a look at what today's events are at the Smithsonian. You have an idea of all the different things that are happening there today. And all of their various museums. . Keeper [indiscernible] might be fun. You can go and watch the giant panda feedings. This is probably a nice place to visit and explore. We are going to head for recreation.gov per that is the main recreation site. I love Marlo model motto. They have tours and tickets and you can get an apartment and because frequently in the summertime if you want to camp in any of the national parks you need supply actually several months in advance and then you can go looking for those and they have tools for her for up planning your trip. Is things that you can click on and those are in your state and maybe you can find somewhere to visit that is in fire. Far. Multiple things to explore with the national recreation.gov. There is also that as a mobile app. You can be standing at the grocery line end and aging about your next vacation. Thus next site is the national Park service. They are dedicated to all of the United States national parks. They feature one every month. We lost her audio, Jane, again. And since I happen to know there is one national Park site and there is also a national forest site I will go for Puerto Rico. Here is the information about that particular site tells you how much economic fit there been. Give it a try and take a search for your state see what you I'm what you can find. If you are traveling you can select regular are going in there is a list of countries and you can choose the place that you'll get health information about that place. And it happens that even though poor creative Puerto Rico is exotic enough you do not need a passport your drivers license works and is nice and warm. You can click on Puerto Rico and you will find us. Information for traveling to the Puerto Rico how to say stay healthy and safe things you might need and how to pack. Clinic nearby. We will take a look at the healthy packing travel list. Anabolic [indiscernible] and altitude glasses and contact lenses and whatever you may need and terms of your own medicine. All of this list over-the-counter medicine. A list of supplies which would include insect repellent we have the good [indiscernible]. So this site is you information including on what to pack founding clinic finding a clinic and any travel notices. So there we are. Travel notices. There are three levels of travel notices. Then there is a list of current travel notices this should [indiscernible]. The health infrastructure of [indiscernible] if you are

going to be traveling abroad it is a good idea to check the site and look at all of these. Travel says. Just to see if there is including right now there is a global measles notice. Just so you [indiscernible]. It is a good place to go if you are traveling outside of the country. My final stop for those of you hard dealing with our dealing with hard winter weather this is the -- site. Jane, we lost sound again.
