

Shelf List Conversion

- Contract with Progressive Technology Federal Systems, Inc. (PTFS) to acquire bibliographic metadata transcription services
 - est. 600,000 non-OCLC cataloging cards in shelf list dating from 1870's through October 1992
 - Convert metadata on cards into machine readable records in MARC21 format to be made accessible through Catalog of U.S. Government Publications (CGP)


Shelf List Conversion

Initial Phase:

- Concentrate on converting 100,000 shelf list cards, monographs and serials
- PTFS Digitizing shelf list cards to create a PDF
- PDF image will be converted to extract the text on the cards moving them into a MARC21 record format

Accomplishments:

- Test batch of shelf list cards completed
- Quality control team reviewing records to provide feedback



Metadata Extraction: An Interagency Project

- 2 year interagency project with Defense Technical Information Service (DTIC) and Old Dominion University (ODU)
 - investigate the feasibility of enhancing the automated metadata extraction tool using documents provided by GPO
 - software will be used to create metadata groups of electronic documents in GPO's electronic collection
- Project completion expected in October 2009
 - Two phases

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Phase 1 of Metadata Extraction

- GPO identified and provided FDLP, in-scope, harvested EPA PDF files to ODU for analysis.
- · ODU analyzed the documents to identify
 - major classes of documents in the collection
 - metadata elements present in each class
 - issues with existing template language for extracting metadata.
- ODU made enhancements to the software and refining templates
- October 2008: completion of Phase I

Authority control

- Awarded a contract to Library Technologies, Inc. to process materials from the "gap period": November 23, 2004 to 2008
 - 60,000 bibliographic records
- Goal is to assess results for future routine authority control for the CGP

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Upcoming projects in FY09

- Digitization workflow
- Analysis of the microfiche operation
- Workflow documentation GPO wide goal

Small Digitization Workflow Test Project

- A collection of approx. 200 tangible Bureau of Reclamation, Mid-Pacific Regional documents
- 111 documents prepared for digitization
 - Going out to FedScan at Library of Congress
- Goal- create digital versions available to FDLP and public through the CGP
