





 US Marine Hospital Service (MHS) in 1798, under the Treasury Department


 Became the U.S. Public Health Service (1930's)






FACT SHEET FOR PATIENTS AND PARENT/CAREGIVERS EMERGENCY USE AUTHORIZATION (EUA) OF HYDROXYCHLOROQUINE SULFATE FOR TREATMENT OF COVID-19 IN CERTAIN HOSPITALIZED PATIENTS

You are being given hydroxychloroquine sulfate to treat COVID-19. This fact sheet contains information to help you understand the risks and benefits of taking the hydroxychloroquine sulfate you have received or may receive.

There is no U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) approved product available to treat COVID-19. Taking hydroxychloroquine sulfate may benefit certain patients hospitalized with COVID-19 for whom a clinical trial is not available, or participation is not feasible. Read this Fact Sheet for information about hydroxychloroquine sulfate. Talk to your health care provider if you have questions. It is your choice to take hydroxychloroquine sulfate or stop it at any time.





FIGURE 7.—One of the three county nurses of the Public Health Service examining pupils in a country schoolhouse before a lunch program is started. This county had the poorest school attendance of any in the State. Lunches were begun as part of the campaign for improvement.
