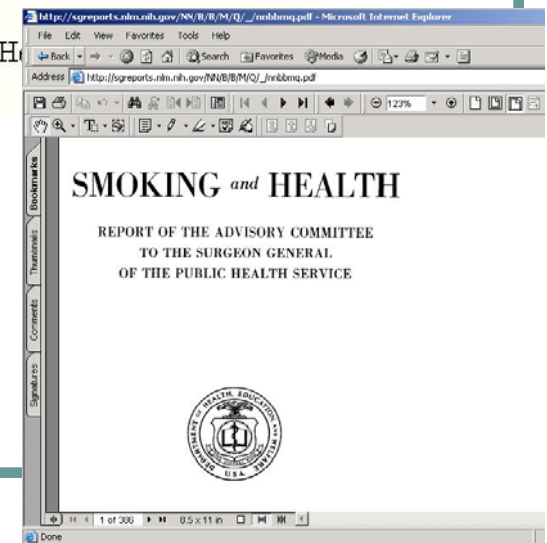

UPRISING AGAINST FOREIGNERS.

LEGATION OF THE UNITED STATES,
Pekin, China, December 7, 1899.

Sir: I regret to report a very critical state of affairs among the missionaries and their converts in certain parts of Shantung.

The season has been a poor one—crops have failed on account of the drought; great poverty and want prevail. An unusual amount of looting is a result, and naturally the foreigners or their followers come in for the larger share of grief.

Early in October last a secret society called "Boxers," in the neighborhood of Ch'ih Ping, assembled with the avowed purpose of driving out foreigners and of extirpating Christians, but, upon aid being requested by the missionaries, soldiers were sent and, on October 18, a conflict ensued which resulted in the killing of some fifty or more of the Boxers and in dispersing them.

The trouble then seemed to be over, but unfortunately a number of citizens of the village where the affair occurred were killed or wounded, in consequence of which the governor arrested the officer commanding the troops and memorialized the Throne for his impeachment, because, the governor says, of the mistake in killing others than the Boxers.

This action of the governor encouraged the Boxers, and they have since rallied again and are doing much damage to the Christian converts, extorting money from them, threatening the missions, and giving ample cause for serious alarm.

sumer demand or in government purchases, technological change, relocation to nonunion areas—will also accent the importance of politics in the union scheme.

Class alignments or shifts in class alignments affect issues and techniques. An ascendant union power in politics generates demands by business and agricultural groups for restriction in union political expenditures and activity and, in turn, generates counterunion activity in politics.

The stage of economic development—in the case of the United States “the affluent society” stage—blunts the cutting edge of wholesale class appeals in the union’s politics. Most importantly, the affluent society dulls the union interest in political programs of fundamental reconstruction.

In short, differentiation in union role in politics can be explained by two sets of factors: The factors relating to the internal union situation—structure, locus of union activity, ideology, personal leadership, role of government in the union’s economy; and the factors in the union’s external environment related to economics and social structure.

PRESENT-DAY ANALYSIS of union-management relations is substantially divorced from the developments in the behavioral science disciplines in which we claim membership, and it is high time we became more sophisticated. The main concern of this paper is to raise some issues about the nature of our analytical problems.

Power and Collective Bargaining


Analysis of the possession of power and its uses depends upon certain value preferences. In our more sophisticated theories of power we have discovered the possibilities of coalitions among power holders which are directed at shared gains often secured at the expense of third parties. Indeed, there is the possibility that strong unions and strong managements in their collective bargaining can enter into coalitions at the expense of third parties. This contrasts with the older and more
