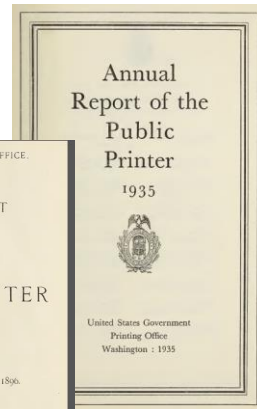
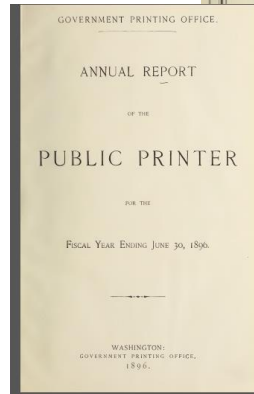


FDsys New Content

National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST)

- Working with GPO to provide access to its legacy and newly-published NIST Technical Series publications on FDsys
- 1,750 publications are available now in the following series:
 - NBS/NIST Technical Notes- 1959-2014
 - NISTIR- 2012-2014
 - NIST Special Publications- 2003-2005, 2011-2014
 - NIST Handbooks- 2013



United States Courts Opinions

- In FY 2015, an additional nine courts were added to the collection.

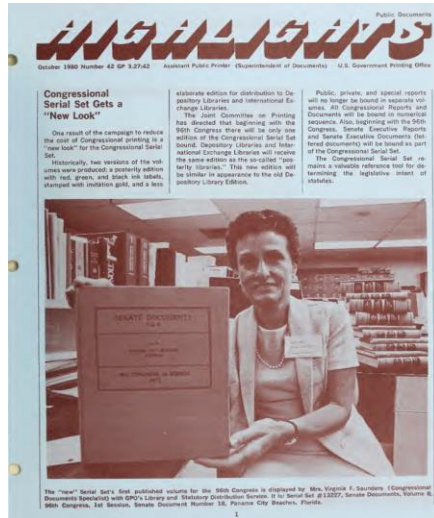

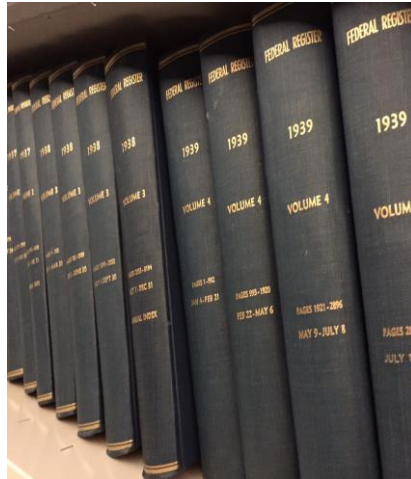
Bound Congressional Record

- GPO expects to be awarding a contract for the descriptive content metadata creation soon.

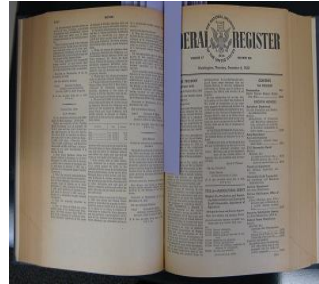
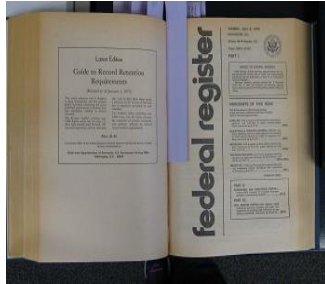
