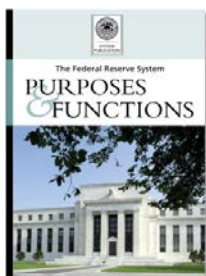
**Federal Reserve Bank of St. Louis's FRASER, FRED, and ALFRED**

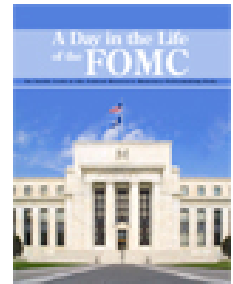
