Additional Language Support for the 2020 Census

Beyond online and phone response in the 12 non-English languages:

- Print and video language guides available online in 59 non-English languages
- Language glossaries for the 59 non-English languages provide key terminology to bilingual staff
- Partnership specialists will be hired from within local communities, emphasizing the importance of communicating in local languages.













Self-Response Mail Strategy

- Two-panel design: Internet First (invitation letter on first contact) and Internet Choice (questionnaire on first contact)
- Internet First panel is divided into four cohorts to best distribute calls to Census Questionnaire Assistance
- Internet Choice panel is in a single cohort, mailed on the same schedule as Internet First, Cohort 2

Nonresponse Followup May 13

Collect data from all households, including group and unique living arrangements

Field workers will use handheld devices for collecting the data

Special Populations – Group Quarters and Service-Based Enumerations

We go to extraordinary lengths to count everyone once, only once, and in the right place

• Group Quarters (GQs) Enumeration

• Places where people live or stay, in a group living arrangement, that are owned or managed by an entity or organization providing housing and/or services for the residents

Service-Based Enumeration

 Provides an opportunity for people without conventional housing or people experiencing homelessness to be included in the census by enumerating them at places where they receive services or at pre-identified outdoor locations.

• Enumeration at Transitory Locations

• Highly mobile populations that do not have a usual home elsewhere (e.g. campgrounds, recreational vehicle parks, marinas, hotels and motels, racetracks, circuses, or carnivals).


Federally Affiliated Count Overseas

• Obtain counts by home state of U.S. military and federal civilian employees stationed overseas and their dependents living with them.

Military Enumeration

 Involves enumeration of people living in GQs (or barracks) on military installations or military vessels.



The 2020 Census is an opportunity to create a better future for our communities and the next generation by providing an up-to-date count of our population. The data collected will help determine how over \$675 billion in federal funding is distributed each year for things like housing assistance, infrastructure, and public transportation.

The 2020 Census and Confidentiality

Your responses to the 2020 Census are safe, secure, and protected by federal law. Your answers can only be used to produce statistics—they cannot be used against you in any way. By law, all responses to U.S. Census Bureau household and business surveys are kept completely confidential.

Respond to the 2020 Census to shape the future.

Responding to the census helps communities get the funding they need and helps businesses make data-driven decisions that grow the economy. Census data impact our daily lives, informing important decisions about funding for services and infrastructure in your community, including health care, senior centers, jobs, political representation, roads, schools, and businesses. More than \$675 billion in federal funding flows back to states and local communities each year based on census data.



Your census responses are safe and secure

The Census Bureau is required by law to protect any personal information we collect and keep it strictly confidential. The Census Bureau can only use your answers to produce statistics. In fact, every Census Bureau employee takes an oath to protect your personal information for life. Your answers cannot be used for law enforcement purposes or to determine your personal eligibility for government benefits.

By law, your responses cannot be used against you.

By law, your census responses cannot be used against you by any government agency or court in any way—not by the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), not by the Central Intelligence Agency (CIA), not by the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), and not by U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE). The law requires the Census Bureau to keep your information confidential and use your responses only to produce statistics.





The law is clear—no

can be shared.

Under Title 13 of the US. Code, the Census Bureau cannot release any identifiable information about individuals, households, or businesses, even to law enforcement agencies. The law states that the information collected may only be used for statisti-

cal purposes and no other purpose. To support historical research, Title 44 of the U.S. Code allows the National Archives and Records Administration to

Records Administration to release census records only after 72 years. All Census Bureau staff tak

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




Community Partnership and Engagement Program


Enroll community partners to increase decennial participation of those who are less likely to respond or are often missed

- Educate people about the 2020 Census and foster cooperation with enumerators
- Encourage community partners to motivate people to self-respond
- Engage grass roots organizations to reach out to hard-to-count groups and those who are not motivated to respond to the national campaign

Mobile Response Initiative = M-QAs

- The Census Bureau responded to the Joint Explanatory Statement for 2019 appropriation by proposing the Mobile Response Initiative.
- We are now calling this the Mobile Questionnaire Assistance Operation (M-QA).
- We're in the planning stages now, developing a detailed operational plan and schedule.
