

The Trust Survey finds public confidence is evenly split between people who say they trust their national government and those who do not.



Trust varies across institutions. The police (67.1%), courts (56.9%), and civil service (50.2%) and local government (46.9%) garner higher levels of public trust than national governments (41.4%) and national legislatures like congresses and parliaments (39.4%)

Disadvantaged groups - young people, women, people with lower incomes and those with less education - are less likely to trust their government and are often sceptical that their government listens to them.



Of 291.5 million people aged 5 and over, 60.6 million people (21 percent of this population) spoke a language other than English at home. While the Census Bureau codes 381 detailed languages, data tabulations are not generally available for all of these detailed groups. Instead, the Census Bureau collapses languages into smaller sets of "language groups.

Immigration and Language Diversity in the United States

As one would expect during an age of mass immigration, the percentage speaking only English at home has steadily fallen in recent decades, declining from 89.1% in 1980 to 79.7% in 2010, while the share speaking a language other than English correspondingly rosefrom 11% to 20.3%.

In absolute numbers the number of persons 5 years and older speaking a language other than English at home rose from 23.1 to 59.5 million, with over two-thirds of the increase attributable to the increasing number of people speaking Spanish at home.


Strategies for reaching your users

- 1. Learn about immigrant groups and speakers of other languages in your area
- 2. Develop partnerships with cultural organizations with ties to groups in your area
- 3. Tailor your outreach services to the sources of information and places that immigrant families rely on
- 4. Work with local government agencies and outreach
- 5. Use staff who speak the languages used in your area or learn another language yourself
- 6. Help your users locate non-government information which corroborates government sources




