



Survey – is a sample count and used in an estimate



- Mail in questionnaires were an option
- Total of 10 questions relating to topics such as:
 - Age
 - Sex
 - Race
 - Ethnicity
 - Rent/Own



Census of Governments



About Census of Governments

- Collected every 5 years, in years ending in "2" and "7"
- Government organization data and information are for October of the year preceding the Census
- How governments are organized, how many people they employ and payroll amounts, and the finances of governments



Census of Governments in Action



- The Bureau of Economic Analysis and the Federal Reserve Board–use the data to measure the nation's economic and financial performance
- State and local governments use the data to develop programs and budgets, assess financial conditions, and perform comparative analyses
- Analysts, economists, market specialists, and researchers need these data to measure the changing characteristics of the government sector of the economy and to conduct public policy research.



Surveys

The Census Bureau conducts more than 130 surveys across the nation

Category	Description
+ Demographic Surveys	Measure income, poverty, education, health insurance coverage, housing quality, crime, computer usage, and many other subjects
Economic Surveys	Measure the nation's economy and provide information about businesses
Sponsored Surveys	Demographic and economic surveys conducted for other government agencies

- Creates estimates for small geographic areas
